"SOROPTIMIST ROMANIA" is a multiannual project of the Soroptimist International Union of Romania (USIR), that invited in 2025 single clubs from the Republic of Moldova TO participate. Both countries have developed the candidacy of the art of traditional blouse (IA) with embroidery on the shoulder (Altiţă), which was included by UNESCO in the List of Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity in 2022.

Culture is more than heritage or tradition — it's the way we connect, create and understand one another. It shapes our identity, drives creativity, and builds resilient, inclusive societies.

Brought together under the theme "Traditions and meanings: IA (the traditional blouse) sewn in various geographical areas of Romania and the Republic of Moldova", the activities reflect traditional popular culture, its understanding and the transmissibility of intangible cultural heritage elements.

The project concludes this stage with the online event on **November 10, 2025**. The reason for choosing the online format is for the possibility to enlarge the participation of members and guests from as many SI clubs as possible on all continents.
