

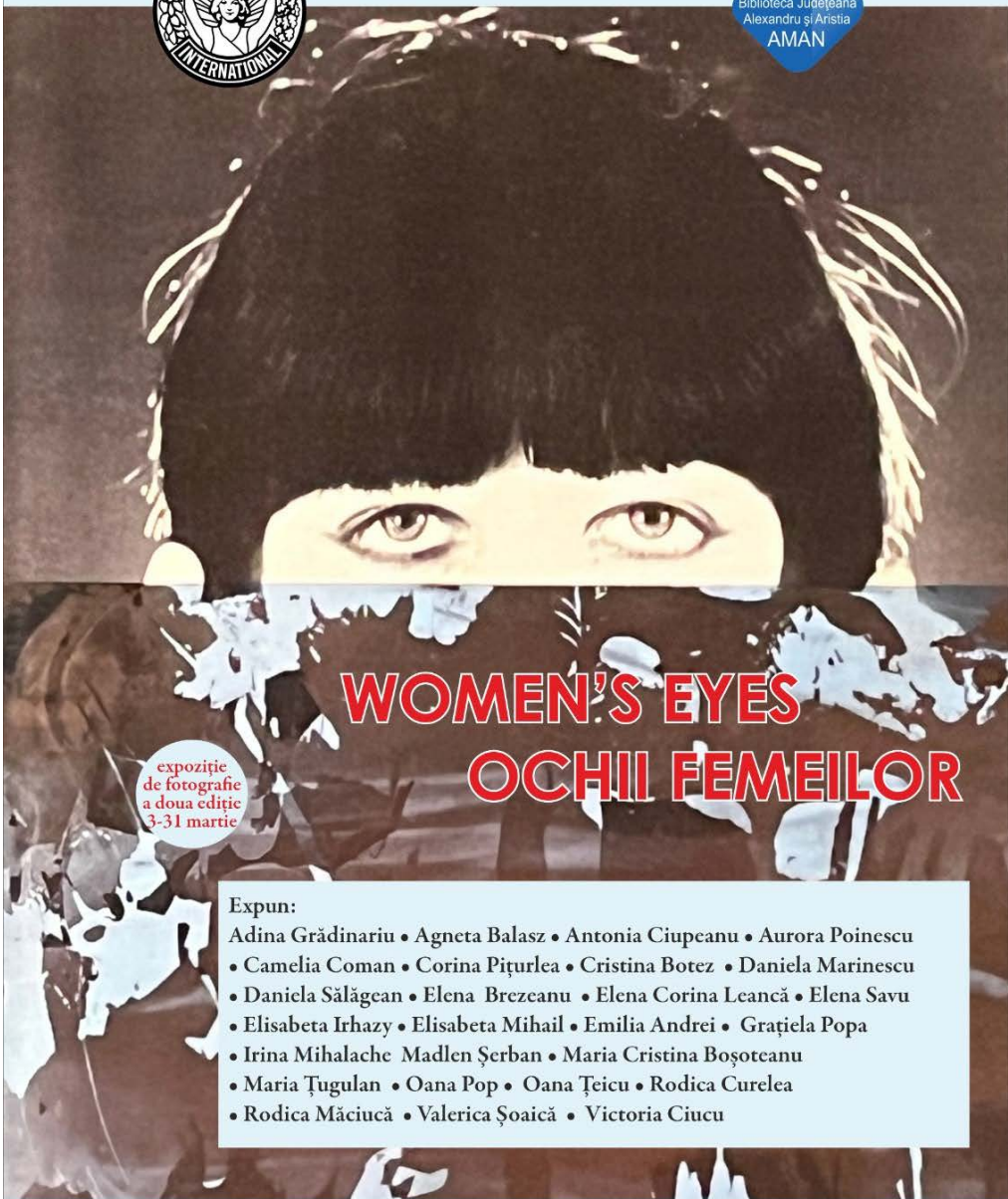

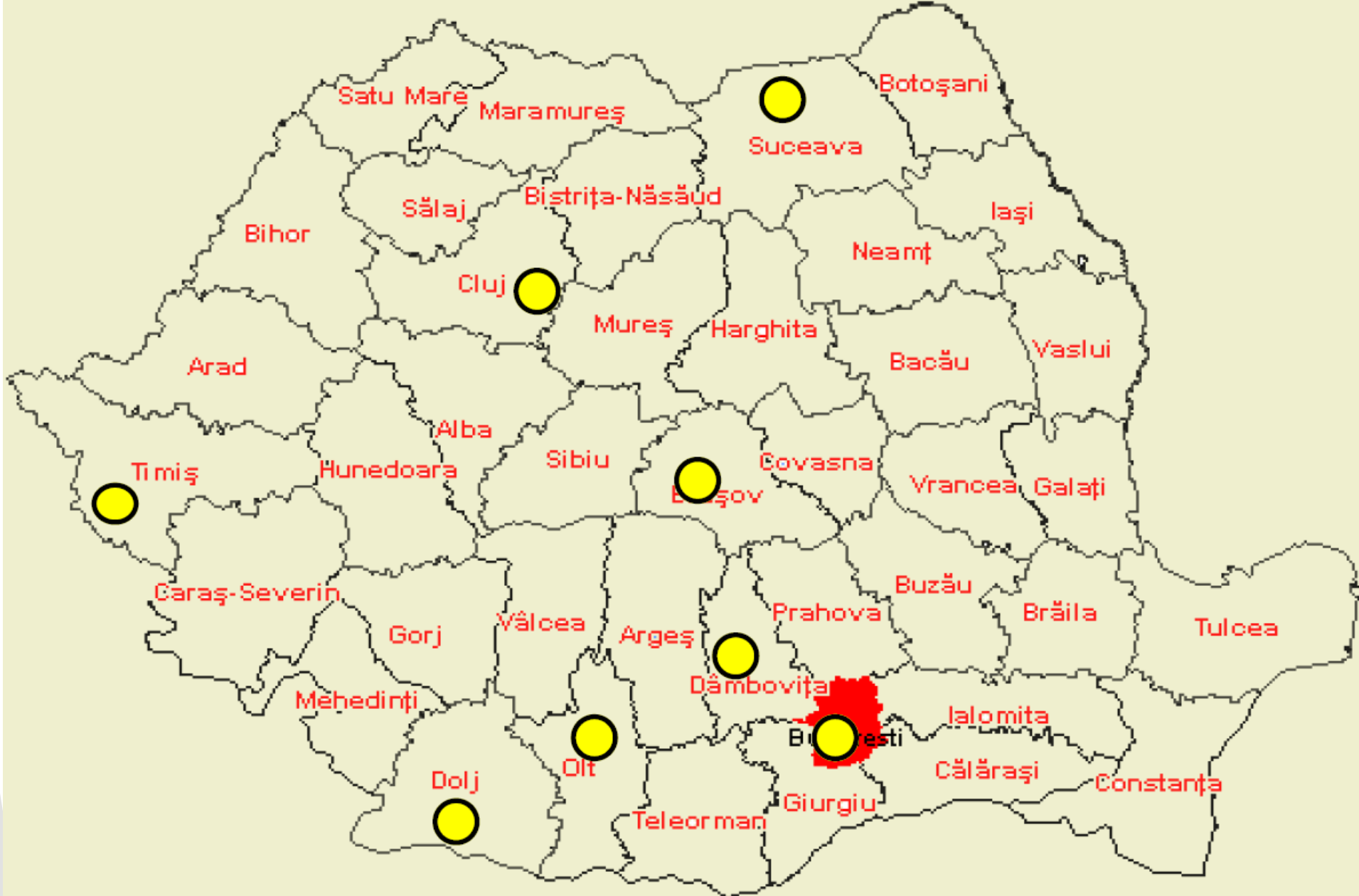

Alexandru and Aristia Aman County Library

▶ On December 21, 1908, in the presence of the Minister of Public Instruction and Religious Affairs, Spiru Haret, the "Alexandru and Aristia Aman" Foundation was inaugurated, patronized by the Craiova City Hall and composed of three sections: library, art gallery and museum. The first institution to donate a significant number of volumes to the library in Craiova was the Romanian Academy.

▶ On September 1, 1921, the poet Elena Farago was appointed to the management of the Aman Foundation. It was the moment when the foundation gradually became a place of art and culture, a literary salon, visited by personalities of the era. In this context, an important book donation was made by Nicolae P. Romanescu, a politician and former mayor of Craiova.

▶ Despite the fact that Alexandru Aman donated his entire family's collection of original paintings, art objects and furniture to establish a public library and museum in Craiova and Aristia Aman, mentioned the same thing in her will of 14 May 1901, by which she donated all her properties on Kogălniceanu Street to the Craiova City Hall, to establish a public library and a picture gallery, only in 1991 it was named after its founders Alexandru and Aristia Aman.
